## A BILL

To require that payment be guaranteed whenever any supplier of electric energy is required to sell electric energy to a purchaser under the emergency authority of section 202(c) of the Federal Power Act, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. GUARANTEE OF PAYMENT REQUIRED FOR CER-**  
4 **TAIN EMERGENCY POWER SALES.**

5 Section 202(c) of the Federal Power Act (16 U.S.C.  
6 825(c)) is amended by adding the following at the end  
7 thereof: “No order may be issued under this subsection

1 unless the payment of compensation or reimbursement to  
2 the person subject to such order is fully guaranteed by  
3 the United States government or by a State government.”.
