# RESOLUTION

Expressing the support for a National Week of Reflection  
and Tolerance.

Whereas the United States is a pluralistic country comprised  
of different races, genders, ethnic groups, religions, and  
creeds;

Whereas our Nation, founded on the principles of tolerance,  
diversity, justice, and equality, should affirm these com-  
mon values and principles; and

Whereas the people of the United States should reflect on the  
importance of understanding and tolerance in our plural-  
istic country: Now, therefore, be it

- 2 Tolerance should be established encouraging communities
- 3 and institutions around the Nation to engage in events
