A BILL

To reauthorize the Tropical Forest Conservation Act of 1998 through fiscal year 2004.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS TO SUP-**
4 **PORT REDUCTION OF DEBT UNDER THE FOR-**
5 **EIGN ASSISTANCE ACT OF 1961 AND TITLE I**
6 **OF THE AGRICULTURAL TRADE DEVELOP-**
7 **MENT AND ASSISTANCE ACT OF 1954.**

8 (a) REAUTHORIZATION.—Section 806 of the Tropical
9 Forest Conservation Act of 1998 (22 U.S.C. 2431d) is

1 amended by adding at the end the following new sub-
2 section:

3 “(d) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS FOR FIS-
4 CAL YEARS AFTER FISCAL YEAR 2001.—For the cost (as
5 defined in section 502(5) of the Federal Credit Reform
6 Act of 1990) for the reduction of any debt pursuant to
7 this section or section 807, there are authorized to be ap-
8 propriated to the President the following:

9 “(1) \$50,000,000 for fiscal year 2002.

10 “(2) \$75,000,000 for fiscal year 2003.

11 “(3) \$100,000,000 for fiscal year 2004.”.

12 (b) CONFORMING AMENDMENT.—Section
13 808(a)(1)(D) of the Tropical Forest Conservation Act of
14 1998 (22 U.S.C. 2431f(a)(1)(D)) is amended by striking
15 “to appropriated under sections 806(a)(2) and 807(a)(2)”
16 and inserting “to be appropriated under sections
17 806(a)(2), 807(a)(2), and 806(d)”.
