## A BILL

To amend title 10, United States Code, to repeal the requirement for reduction of SBP survivor annuities by dependency and indemnity compensation.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. REPEAL OF REQUIREMENT OF REDUCTION OF**  
4                       **SBP SURVIVOR ANNUITIES BY DEPENDENCY**  
5                       **AND INDEMNITY COMPENSATION.**

6           (a) REPEAL.—Section 1451(c) of title 10, United  
7       States Code, is amended by striking paragraph (2).

8           (b) PROHIBITION ON RETROACTIVE BENEFITS.—No  
9       benefits may be paid to any person for any period before

1 the effective date specified in subsection (c) by reason of  
2 the amendment made by subsection (a).

3 (c) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by  
4 subsection (a) shall take effect on—

5 (1) the first day of the first month that begins  
6 after the date of the enactment of this Act; or

7 (2) the first day of the fiscal year that begins  
8 in the calendar year in which this Act is enacted, if  
9 later than the date specified in paragraph (1).
