Mrs. LINCOLN introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred
to the Committee on Banking, Housing, and Urban Affairs

A BILL

To amend the Federal Deposit Insurance Act to clarify what
lending entities are subject to section 44(f) of that Act,
and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. TECHNICAL AMENDMENTS.**

4 Section 44(f) of the Federal Deposit Insurance Act
5 (12 U.S.C. 1831u(f)) is amended—

6 (1) in paragraph (1), by striking “loan or dis-
7 count” and all that follows through “the greater
8 of—” and inserting “loan, discount, or credit sale
9 made or upon any note, bill of exchange, financing
10 transaction, or other evidence of debt issued to or

1 acquired by any competing lender, shall be equal to
2 not more than the greater of—”;

3 (2) in paragraph (2), by striking subparagraph
4 (A) and inserting the following:

5 “(A) the authority of any competing lender
6 to take, receive, reserve, or charge interest on
7 any loan or credit sale made in any State other
8 than the State referred to in paragraph (1);
9 or”; and

10 (3) by adding at the end the following:

11 “(3) DEFINITION.—In this subsection, the term
12 ‘competing lender’ means—

13 “(A) any insured depository institution,
14 the home State of which is described in para-
15 graph (1); and

16 “(B) any person or entity engaged in the
17 business of selling or financing the sale of prop-
18 erty or services in a State that is described in
19 paragraph (1).”.
