2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. EXTENSION OF MORATORIUM ON IMPOSITION
4 OF TAXES ON THE INTERNET.**

5 Section 1101(a) of the Omnibus Consolidated and
6 Emergency Supplemental Appropriations Act, 1999 is
7 amended by striking “3 years” and inserting “8 years”.
