CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

Supporting the goals and ideals of “National Community Residential Care Month”.

Whereas the need for quality and dependable health care for the elderly, disabled, and mentally ill increases every year;

Whereas community residential care provides medical, social, and nutritional assistance to individuals who cannot provide for themselves;

Whereas the community residential care industry provides a workable and home-like environment for individuals unable to care for themselves at home, and does so in a manner which promotes confidence, support, and self-esteem for the individuals receiving such care;

Whereas the community residential care industry is staffed by committed, hardworking professionals who dedicate their working lives to the care of the elderly, disabled, and mentally ill;

Whereas persons providing community residential care must meet stringent licensing requirements;

Whereas both the national and international community residential care industry are deserving of recognition and appreciation; and

Whereas the Community Residential Care Association of California has designated the month of May as “National Community Residential Care Month”: Now, therefore, be it

 4 quests that the President issue a proclamation calling on
