# A BILL

To exempt small trailer manufacturers from enhanced early warning reporting requirements under the Transportation Recall Enhancement, Accountability, and Documentation (TREAD) Act.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled.*

3 SECTION 1. WEIGHT EXEMPTION FOR CLASSIFICATION OF  
4 TRAILER MANUFACTURERS.

5 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, for pur-  
6 poses of the early warning reporting requirements con-  
7 tained in section 30166(m), title 49, United States Code,  
8 manufacturers of trailers rated 26,000 pounds or less

1 gross vehicle weight shall not, for such trailers, be subject  
2 to the additional reporting requirements required of man-  
3 ufacturers who produce, import, offer for sale, or sell more  
4 than 500 vehicles, under section 573 of title 49, Code of  
5 Federal Regulations.
