RESOLUTION

Congratulating the New Jersey Devils for winning the 2003
Stanley Cup championship.

Whereas on June 9, 2003, the New Jersey Devils won their
3rd Stanley Cup championship in 9 years by defeating
the Anaheim Mighty Ducks, 4 games to 3;

Whereas the New Jersey Devils set a National Hockey
League record by winning 12 home games in a single
playoff year;

Whereas New Jersey Devils' goaltender Martin Brodeur tied
a Stanley Cup finals record with 3 shutouts in the finals
and established a record for the most shutouts in a single
playoff year with 7;

Whereas team captain Scott Stevens set a National Hockey League record for playing in his 233rd playoff game as a defenseman; and

Whereas the determination and teamwork shown by the New Jersey Devils in winning the Stanley Cup embody the best of the work ethic and unity of the people of New Jersey: Now, therefore, be it
