Whereas Ben Curtis was a relatively unknown golfer before he arrived in Britain for his first major tournament, the 2003 British Open, which was also his first tournament on a links course;

Whereas Mr. Curtis's win at the 2003 British Open was the most unexpected and unpredictable in the recent history of the 143-year-old event;

Whereas the mental toughness and physical ability displayed by Mr. Curtis are the hallmarks of a true champion;

Whereas Mr. Curtis became the first golfer since 1913 to win a major tournament on his first attempt;

Whereas Mr. Curtis made his family, the citizens of Ohio, and our Nation proud with his outstanding performance; and

Whereas it is appropriate to recognize the important role that athletic events play in American life: Now, therefore, be it
