5 **SEC. 2. REFERENCES.**

8 to the Federal building and United States Courthouse re-
9 ferred to in section 1 shall be deemed to be a reference
10 to the James L. Buckley Annex to the E. Barrett
11 Prettyman United States Courthouse.
