1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*
3 **SECTION 1. FRANCIS X. MCCLOSKEY POST OFFICE BUILD-
4 ING.**

5 (a) DESIGNATION.—The facility of the United States
6 Postal Service located at 3210 East 10th Street in Bloom-
7 ington, Indiana, shall be known and designated as the
8 “Francis X. McCloskey Post Office Building”.

1 (b) REFERENCES.—Any reference in a law, map, reg-
2 ulation, document, paper, or other record of the United
3 States to the facility referred to in subsection (a) shall
4 be deemed to be a reference to the Francis X. McCloskey
5 Post Office Building.
