## A BILL

To designate the facility of the United States Postal Service located at 475 Kell Farm Drive in Cape Girardeau, Missouri, as the “Richard G. Wilson Processing and Distribution Facility”.

2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. RICHARD G. WILSON PROCESSING AND DIS-**  
4 **TRIBUTION FACILITY.**

5 (a) DESIGNATION.—The facility of the United States  
6 Postal Service located at 475 Kell Farm Drive in Cape  
7 Girardeau, Missouri, shall be known and designated as the  
8 “Richard G. Wilson Processing and Distribution Facility”.

1       (b) REFERENCES.—Any reference in a law, map, reg-  
2   ulation, document, paper, or other record of the United  
3   States to the facility referred to in subsection (a) shall  
4   be deemed to be a reference to the Richard G. Wilson  
5   Processing and Distribution Facility.
