3 **SECTION 1. DESIGNATION OF NATHANIEL R. JONES FED-**

7 located at 10 East Commerce Street in Youngstown, Ohio,

1 shall be known and designated as the “Nathaniel R. Jones
2 Federal Building and United States Courthouse”.

3 **SEC. 2. REFERENCES.**

4 Any reference in a law, map, regulation, document,
5 paper, or other record of the United States to the Federal
6 building and United States courthouse referred to in sec-
7 tion 1 shall be deemed to be a reference to the “Nathaniel
8 R. Jones Federal Building and United States Court-
9 house”.
