## A BILL

To designate a United States courthouse to be constructed in Fresno, California, as the “Robert E. Coyle United States Courthouse”.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-  
2       tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. DESIGNATION.**

4       The United States courthouse to be constructed on  
5 a parcel of land bounded by O Street, P Street, Tulare  
6 Street, and Capitol Street in Fresno California, shall be  
7 known and designated as the “Robert E. Coyle United  
8 States Courthouse”.

**1 SEC. 2. REFERENCES.**

2 Any reference in a law, map, regulation, document,  
3 paper, or other record of the United States to the United  
4 States courthouse referred to in section 1 shall be deemed  
5 to be a reference to the "Robert E. Coyle United States  
6 Courthouse".
