A BILL

To amend title 37, United States Code, to alleviate delay in the payment of the Selected Reserve reenlistment bonus to members of Selected Reserve who are mobilized.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*

2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. PAYMENT OF SELECTED RESERVE REENLIST-**

4 **MENT BONUS TO MEMBERS OF SELECTED RE-**

5 **SERVE WHO ARE MOBILIZED.**

6 Section 308b of title 37, United States Code, is

7 amended—

8 (1) by redesignating subsections (d), (e), and

9 (f) as subsections (e), (f), and (g), respectively; and

(2) by inserting after subsection (c) the following new subsection (d):

3 “(d) PAYMENT TO MOBILIZED MEMBERS.—In the
4 case of a member entitled to a bonus under this section
5 who is called or ordered to active duty, any amount of
6 such bonus that is payable to the member during the pe-
7 riod of active duty of the member shall be paid the mem-
8 ber during that period of active duty, notwithstanding the
9 service of the member on active duty pursuant to such
10 call or order to active duty.”.
