A BILL

To redesignate the facility of the United States Postal Service located at 7401 West 100th Place in Bridgeview, Illinois, as the “Michael J. Healy Post Office Building”.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. MICHAEL J. HEALY POST OFFICE BUILDING.**

4 (a) REDESIGNATION.—The facility of the United
5 States Postal Service located at 7401 West 100th Place
6 in Bridgeview, Illinois, and known as the Moraine Valley
7 Post Office, shall be known and designated as the “Mi-
8 chael J. Healy Post Office Building”.

1 (b) REFERENCES.—Any reference in a law, map, reg-
2 ulation, document, paper, or other record of the United
3 States to the facility referred to in subsection (a) shall
4 be deemed to be a reference to the Michael J. Healy Post
5 Office Building.
