A BILL

To amend the Robert T. Stafford Disaster Relief and Emergency Assistance Act to make private, nonprofit medical facilities that serve industry-specific clients eligible for hazard mitigation and disaster assistance.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. HAZARD MITIGATION AND DISASTER ASSIST-**
4 **ANCE FOR CERTAIN PRIVATE, NONPROFIT**
5 **MEDICAL FACILITIES.**

6 Section 102(9) of the Robert T. Stafford Disaster
7 Relief and Emergency Assistance Act (42 U.S.C. 5122(9))
8 is amended—

1 (1) by striking “‘Private nonprofit facility’
2 means” and inserting the following:

3 “(A) IN GENERAL.—The term ‘private
4 nonprofit facility’ means”; and

5 (2) by adding at the end the following:

6 “(B) INCLUSION.—The term ‘private non-
7 profit facility’ includes a facility that—

8 “(i) provides medical services to a spe-
9 cific occupational or industrial segment of
10 the public; and

11 “(ii) is operated by an organization
12 described in subsection (c) or (d) of section
13 501 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986
14 (26 U.S.C. 501) that is exempt from tax-
15 ation under section 501(a) of that Code.”.
