8 **ICES.**—Section 1701(10)(A) of title 38, United States

1 Code, is amended by striking “the date of the enactment
2 of the Veterans Millennium Health Care and Benefits Act
3 and ending on December 31, 2003,” and inserting “No-
4 vember 30, 1999, and ending on December 31, 2008.”.

5 (b) REQUIRED NURSING HOME CARE.—Section
6 1710A(c) of such title is amended by striking “December
7 31, 2003” and inserting “December 31, 2008”.

8 (c) ADDITIONAL REPORT ON EXTENDED CARE
9 SERVICES.—Section 101(i) of the Veterans Millennium
10 Health Care and Benefits Act (Public Law 106–117; 113
11 Stat. 1550; 38 U.S.C. 1710A note) is amended—

12 (1) by striking “REPORT.—” and inserting
13 “REPORTS.—”;

14 (2) in the first sentence, by inserting “and Jan-
15 uary 1, 2008,” after “January 1, 2003,”; and

16 (3) in the second sentence, by striking “the re-
17 port” and inserting “each report”.

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
