A BILL

To provide State and local governments with flexibility in using funds made available for homeland security activities.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. GRANTS BY THE OFFICE OF DOMESTIC PRE-**
4 **PAREDNESS.**

5 Section 430 of the Homeland Security Act of 2002
6 (6 U.S.C. 238) is amended by adding at the end the fol-
7 lowing:

8 “(e) STATE AND LAND SECURITY GRANTS.—

9 “(1) SET ASIDE.—Not to exceed 20 percent of
10 the amount of any grant by the Office of Depart-

1 “(2) USE FOR LOCAL GOVERNMENTS.—For the
2 purpose of meeting any requirement that a State
3 provide grant funds to local governments from a
4 grant made available under this Act for homeland
5 security activities, any grant funds that are ex-
6 pended by the State to carry out homeland security
7 activities on behalf of local governments shall be
8 considered to be provided to local governments.”.
