# A BILL

To amend the National Security Act of 1947 to prohibit persons who disclose classified information from holding a security clearance for access to such information.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 SECTION 1. REVOCATION OF SECURITY CLEARANCE FOR  
4 PERSONS THAT DISCLOSE CLASSIFIED IN-  
5 FORMATION.

6 Title VI of the National Security Act of 1947 (50  
7 U.S.C. 421 et seq.) is amended by inserting after section  
8 605 the following new section:

1   **“SEC. 605A. REVOCATION OF SECURITY CLEARANCE FOR**  
2                   **PERSONS THAT DISCLOSE CLASSIFIED IN-**  
3                   **FORMATION.**

4       “(a) Any Federal employee who discloses, or has dis-  
5       closed, classified information, including the identity of a  
6       covert agent of the Central Intelligence Agency, to a per-  
7       son not authorized to receive such information shall not  
8       be permitted to hold a security clearance for access to such  
9       information.”.
