## A BILL

To amend title 13, United States Code, to provide for a just apportionment of Representatives in Congress for all States.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-  
2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

**3 SECTION 1. USE OF SAMPLING.**

4       Section 195 of title 13, United States Code, is  
5 amended by striking “Except for the determination of  
6 population for purposes of apportionment of Representa-  
7 tives in Congress among the several States, the” and in-  
8 serting “The”.
