A BILL

To extend the temporary suspension of duty on certain ion-exchange resins.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. CERTAIN ION-EXCHANGE RESINS.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Heading 9902.39.30 of the Har-
5 monized Tariff Schedule of the United States (relating to
6 certain ion-exchange resins) is amended by striking “12/
7 31/2006” and inserting “12/31/2008”.

8 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
9 subsection (a) applies to goods entered, or withdrawn from

- 1 warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day after
- 2 the date of enactment of this Act.
