3       **SECTION 1. RAYMOND J. SALMON POST OFFICE.**

7       mond J. Salmon Post Office”.

8       (b) REFERENCES.—Any reference in a law, map, reg-

9       ulation, document, paper, or other record of the United

1 States to the facility referred to in subsection (a) shall  
2 be deemed to be a reference to the “Raymond J. Salmon  
3 Post Office”.
