## A BILL

To extend temporarily the suspension of duty on 3,3',4,4'-  
Biphenyltetracarboxylic Dianhydride.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION       1.       3,3',4,4'-BIPHENYLTETRACARBOXYLIC**  
4       **DIANHYDRIDE.**

5       (a) IN GENERAL.—Heading 9902.05.11 of the Har-  
6       monized Tariff Schedule of the United States (relating to  
7       3,3',4,4'-Biphenyltetracarboxylic Dianhydride) is amended  
8       by striking “12/31/2006” and inserting “12/31/2009”.

9       (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by  
10      subsection (a) applies to goods entered, or withdrawn from

- 1 warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day after
- 2 the date of enactment of this Act.
