# A BILL

To suspend temporarily the duty on fabric woven with certain continuous filament wholly nylon type-66 textured yarns.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 SECTION 1. FABRIC WOVEN WITH CERTAIN CONTINUOUS  
4 FILAMENT WHOLLY NYLON TYPE-66 TEX-  
5 TURED YARNS.

6 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of  
7 the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is  
8 amended by inserting in numerical sequence the following  
9 new heading:

“	9902.10.02	Fabric woven with continuous filament wholly nylon type-66 textured yarns, such fabric capable of stretching by at least 100 percent in the weft direction and having a tenacity of less than 53 cN/tex (provided for in subheading 5407.41.00) .....	Free	No change	No change	On or before 12/31/2009	”.

1           (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by  
 2 subsection (a) applies to goods entered, or withdrawn from  
 3 warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day after  
 4 the date of enactment of this Act.
