To suspend temporarily the duty on certain compounds of lanthanum, cerium, and terbium phosphates.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. CERTAIN COMPOUNDS OF LANTHANUM, CE-
4 RIUM, AND TERBIUM PHOSPHATES.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of
6 the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is
7 amended by inserting in numerical sequence the following
8 new heading:

“	9902.10.03	Compounds, inorganic or organic, of rare-earth metals, of lanthanum, cerium, and terbium phosphates (provided for in subheadings 2846.10.00 and 2846.90.80)	Free	No change	No change	On or before	”.
