## A BILL

To suspend temporarily the duty on a certain infrared absorbing dye.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. INFRARED ABSORBING DYE.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of  
5 the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is  
6 amended by inserting in numerical sequence the following  
7 new heading:

“	9902.29.43	1H-Benz[e]indolium, 2-[2-[2-chloro-3-[(1,3-dihydro-1,1,3-trimethyl-2H-benz[e]indol-2-ylidene)ethylidene]-1-cyclohexen-1-yl]ethenyl]-1,1,3-trimethyl-, salt with 4-methylbenzenesulfonic acid (1:1) (CAS No. 134127–48–3) (provided for in subheading 2934.99.90) ..... 1       (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by  
2 subsection (a) shall apply with respect to goods entered,  
3 or withdrawn from warehouse for consumption, on or after  
4 the date that is 15 days after the date of enactment of
