A BILL

To extend and modify duty suspensions relating to wool, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. EXTENSION AND MODIFICATION OF DUTY SUS-
4 PENSION ON WOOL PRODUCTS, WOOL RE-
5 SEARCH FUND, WOOL DUTY REFUNDS.**

6 (a) EXTENSION OF TEMPORARY DUTY REDUC-
7 TIONS.—

8 (1) HEADING 9902.51.11.—Heading 9902.51.11
9 of the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United

1 States is amended by striking “12/31/2007” and in-
2 serting “12/31/2011”.

3 (2) HEADING 9902.51.13.—Heading 9902.51.13
4 of the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United
5 States is amended by striking “12/31/2007” and in-
6 serting “12/31/2011”.

7 (3) HEADING 9902.51.14.—Heading 9902.51.14
8 of the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United
9 States is amended by striking “12/31/2007” and in-
10 serting “12/31/2011”.

11 (4) HEADING 9902.51.15.—Heading 9902.51.15
12 of the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United
13 States (relating to fabrics of combed wool) is amend-
14 ed by striking “12/31/2006” and inserting “12/31/
15 2011”.

16 (5) HEADING 9902.51.16.—Heading 9902.51.16
17 of the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United
18 States (relating to fabrics of combed wool) is amend-
19 ed by striking “12/31/2006” and inserting “12/31/
20 2011”.

21 (b) EXTENSION OF DUTY REFUNDS AND WOOL RE-
22 SEARCH TRUST FUND.—Section 4002(c) of the “Wool
23 Suit and Textile Trade Extension Act of 2004” (Public
24 Law 108-429; 118 Stat. 2603) is amended—

25 (1) in paragraph (3)—

1 (A) by striking “2 additional payments”
2 and inserting “annual additional payments”;
3 and

4 (B) by adding at the end the following:

5 “(C) Each subsequent annual payment to
6 be made after January 1 of each subsequent
7 year, but on or before April 15 of such year.”;

8 (2) in paragraph (5), by striking “12/31/2008”

9 and inserting “12/31/2012”; and

10 (3) in paragraph (6)—

11 (A) in subparagraph (A), by striking
12 “through 2007” and inserting “through 2011”;

13 and

14 (B) by adding at the end of such subparagraph-
15 graph the following:

16 “(C) ELIGIBLE MANUFACTURERS.—Only
17 manufacturers who weave worsted wool fabric
18 in the United States shall be eligible for a grant
19 under this paragraph.”.

20 (c) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendments made by
21 subsection (a) apply to goods entered, or withdrawn from
22 warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day after
23 the date of enactment of this Act.
