3 **SECTION 1. SUSPENSION OF DUTY ON DICHLOPROP-P**
4 **ACID, DICHLOPROP-P DIMETHYLAMINE**
5 **SALT, AND DICHLOPROP-P 2-ETHYLHEXYL**
6 **ESTER.**

7 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of
8 the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is

1 amended by inserting in numerical sequence the following

2 new heading:

“	9902.____	(+)-(R)-2-(2,4-dichlorophenoxy) propanoic acid (CAS No. 15165-67-0); (+)-(R)-2-(2,4-dichlorophenoxy) propanoic acid, 2-ethylhexyl ester (CAS No. 79270-78-3) (provided for in subheading 2918.90.20); and (+)-(R)-2-(2,4-dichlorophenoxy) propanoic acid, dimethylamine salt (CAS No. 104786-87-0) (provided for in subheading 2921.19.60)	Free	No change	No change	On or before 12/31/2008	”.

3 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
