## A BILL

To suspend temporarily the duty on ground fault circuit interrupter receptacles of greater than 15 amps.

3       **SECTION 1. CERTAIN GROUND FAULT CIRCUIT INTER-**  
4                       **RUPTER RECEPTACLES OF GREATER THAN 15**  
5                       **AMPS.**

6       (a) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of  
7       the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is  
8       amended by inserting in numerical sequence the following  
9       new heading:

1           (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by  
 2 subsection (a) applies to goods entered, or withdrawn from  
 3 warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day after
