A BILL

To suspend temporarily the duty on digital zoom camera lenses not exceeding 20 ounces in weight.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. DIGITAL ZOOM CAMERA LENSES NOT EXCEED-**
4 **ING 20 OUNCES IN WEIGHT.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of
6 the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is
7 amended by inserting in numerical sequence the following
8 new heading:

“	9902.11.04	Lenses for digital cameras with focal length between 18 mm and 200 mm inclusive, greater than 18 oz. in weight and not exceeding 20 oz. (provided for in subheading 9002.11.90)	Free	No change	No change	On or before 12/31/2009	”.

1 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
2 subsection (a) applies to goods entered, or withdrawn from
3 warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day after
4 the date of the enactment of this Act.
