A BILL

To suspend temporarily the duty on certain black and white
monitors.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 SECTION 1. BLACK AND WHITE MONITORS.

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of
5 the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is
6 amended by inserting in numerical sequence the following
7 new heading:

“	9902.85.30	Black and white monitors, with a video display diagonal of 22.86 cm or 30.48 cm or 43.18 cm, of a kind used as analog display devices in video security systems (provided for in subheading 8528.22.00)	Free	No change	No change	On or before 12/31/2009	”.
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1 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
2 subsection (a) applies to goods entered, or withdrawn from
3 warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day after
4 the date of the enactment of this Act.
