Mr. SPECTER introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Finance

A BILL

To provide for the liquidation or reliquidation of certain entries relating to fiberboard.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. ENTRIES OF CERTAIN FIBERBOARD.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding section 514 of
5 the Tariff Act of 1930 (19 U.S.C. 1514) or any other pro-
6 vision of law, the Bureau of Customs and Border Protec-
7 tion shall, not later than 90 days after the receipt of the
8 request described in subsection (b), liquidate or reliquidate
9 at a rate of duty of 1.9 cents per kilogram plus 1.5 percent
10 ad valorem for the entries of fiberboard of a density ex-

ceeding 0.8 grams per cubic centimeter described in subsection (d).

(b) REQUEST.—Liquidation or reliquidation may be made under subsection (a) with respect to an entry described in subsection (d) only if a request is filed with the Bureau of Customs and Border Protection not later than 90 days after the date of the enactment of this Act.

(c) REFUND OF AMOUNTS OWED.—Any amounts owed by the United States pursuant to the liquidation or reliquidation of an entry described in subsection (d) (including interest from the date of entry) shall be refunded not later than 90 days after the date of such liquidation or reliquidation.
