A BILL

To suspend temporarily the duty on titanium dioxide anatase.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 SECTION 1. TITANIUM DIOXIDE ANATASE.

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of
5 the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is
6 amended by inserting in numerical sequence the following
7 new heading:

“	9902.28.23	Titanium dioxide (anatase type) (CAS No. 1317-70-0) (provided for in sub- heading 2823.00.00)	Free	No change	No change	On or before 12/31/2009	”.

8 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
9 this section shall apply with respect to goods entered, or

- 1 withdrawn from warehouse for consumption, on or after
- 2 the 15th day after the date of enactment of this Act.
