## A BILL

To reduce temporarily the duty on formulations of  
Azoxystrobin.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. FORMULATIONS OF AZOXYSTROBIN.**

4       (a) CALENDAR YEAR 2007.—Subchapter II of chap-  
5 ter 99 of the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United  
6 States is amended by inserting in numerical sequence the  
7 following new heading:

“	9902.12.51	Mixtures of benzeneacetic acid, ( $\alpha$ E)- 2-[(6-(2-cyanophenoxy)-4-pyrimidinyl)oxy]- $\alpha$ -(methoxymethylene)-, methyl ester (Azoxystrobin) (CAS No. 131860-33-8) and application adjuvants (provided for in subheading 3808.20.15) .....	6.14%	No change	No change	On or before 12/31/2007	”

1 (b) CALENDAR YEAR 2008.—

4 (A) by striking “6.14%” and inserting  
5 “6.15%”; and

6 (B) by striking “On or before 12/31/2007”  
7 and inserting “On or before 12/31/2008”.

11 (c) CALENDAR YEAR 2009.—

12 (1) IN GENERAL.—Heading 9902.12.51, as  
13 added by subsection (a) and amended by subsection  
14 (b), is further amended—

15 (A) by striking “6.15%” and inserting  
16 “6.17%”; and

17 (B) by striking “On or before 12/31/2008”  
18 and inserting “On or before 12/31/2009”.
