## A BILL

To suspend temporarily the duty on certain synthetic staple fibers that are not carded, combed, or otherwise processed for spinning.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. ACRYLIC OR MODACRYLIC SYNTHETIC STAPLE**  
4                       **FIBERS, NOT CARDED, COMBED, OR OTHER-**  
5                       **WISE PROCESSED FOR SPINNING.**

6       (a) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of  
7       the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is  
8       amended by inserting in numerical sequence the following  
9       new heading:

“	9902.06.42	Synthetic staple fibers, not carded, combed, or otherwise processed for spinning: acrylic or modacrylic (provided for in subheading 5503.30.00) .....	Free	No change	No change	On or before 12/31/2009	”.

1           (b) **EFFECTIVE DATE.**—The amendment made by  
2 subsection (a) applies to articles entered, or withdrawn  
3 from warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day  
4 after the date of the enactment of this Act.
