3 **SECTION 1. 9H-THIOXANTHENE-2-CARBOXALDEHYDE, 9-
4 OXO-, 2-(O-ACETYLOXIME) (9Cl).**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of
6 the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is
7 amended by inserting in numerical sequence the following
8 new heading:

“	9902.29.12	9H-Thioxanthene-2-carboxaldehyde, 9-oxo-, 2-(o-acetyloxime) (9Cl) (provided for in subheading 2934.99.39) (CAS No. 362624-80-4)	Free	No change	No change	On or before 12/31/2009	”.

1 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
2 subsection (a) applies to goods entered, or withdrawn from
3 warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day after
