## A BILL

To suspend temporarily the duty on unbleached sheeting.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
 2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*  
 3 **SECTION 1. UNBLEACHED SHEETING.**  
 4       (a) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of  
 5 the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is  
 6 amended by inserting in numerical sequence the following  
 7 new heading:

“	9902.52.09	Unbleached sheeting, less than 85 percent by weight of cotton, mixed mainly or solely with man-made fibers, less than or equal to 200 g/m <sup>2</sup> , of average yarn, number 42 or lower number, of width exceeding 225 centimeters (provided for in subheading 5210.11.40) .....	Free	No change	No change	On or before 12/31/2009	”.

1        (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by  
2 subsection (a) applies to goods entered, or withdrawn from  
3 warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day after  
4 the date of the enactment of this Act.
