To suspend temporarily the duty on certain unbleached
printcloth.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. CERTAIN UNBLEACHED PRINTCLOTH.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of
5 the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is
6 amended by inserting in numerical sequence the following
7 new heading:

“	9902.52.12	Unbleached printcloth, greater than or equal to 85 percent by weight of cotton, greater than 100 g/m ² but less than or equal to 200 g/m ² , of average yarn, number 43 to 68, of width exceeding 225 centimeters (provided for in subheading 5208.12.60)	Free	No change	No change	On or before 12/31/2009	”.

1 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
2 subsection (a) applies to goods entered, or withdrawn from
3 warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day after
4 the date of the enactment of this Act.
