## A BILL

To suspend temporarily the duty on certain Giardiniera prepared or preserved otherwise than by vinegar or acetic acid in concentrations less than 0.5 percent.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-  
2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. CERTAIN GIARDINIERA PREPARED OR PRE-  
4 SERVED OTHERWISE THAN BY VINEGAR OR  
5 ACETIC ACID IN CONCENTRATIONS LESS  
6 THAN 0.5 PERCENT.**

7       (a) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of  
8 the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is

- 1 amended by inserting in numerical sequence the following
- 2 new heading:

“	9902.10.30	Giardiniera, containing red peppers and chili peppers, prepared or preserved otherwise than by vinegar, not frozen (provided for in subheading 2005.90.97) .....	Free	No change	No change	On or before 12/31/2009	”.

- 3 (b) **EFFECTIVE DATE.**—The amendment made by subsection (a) applies to goods entered, or withdrawn from warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day after the date of the enactment of this Act.
