A BILL

To suspend temporarily the duty on weft pile fabrics of cotton, other than uncut weft pile fabrics or cut corduroy.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. WEFT PILE FABRICS OF COTTON, OTHER THAN
4 UNCUT WEFT PILE FABRICS OR CUT COR-
5 DROY.**

6 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of
7 the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is
8 amended by inserting in numerical sequence the following
9 new heading:

“	9902.58.01	Weft pile fabrics of cotton, other than uncut weft pile fabrics or cut corduroy (provided for in subheading 5801.23)	Free	No change	No change	On or before 12/31/2009	”.

1 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
2 subsection (a) applies to goods entered, or withdrawn from
3 warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day after
4 the date of the enactment of this Act.
