3 **SECTION 1. HAMILTON H. JUDSON POST OFFICE.**

4 (a) DESIGNATION.—The facility of the United States

5 Postal Service located at 216 Oak Street in Farmington,

6 Minnesota, shall be known and designated as the “Ham-

7 ilton H. Judson Post Office”.

8 (b) REFERENCES.—Any reference in a law, map, reg-

9 ulation, document, paper, or other record of the United

1 States to the facility referred to in subsection (a) shall
2 be deemed to be a reference to the “Hamilton H. Judson
3 Post Office”.
