A BILL

To authorize the project for hurricane and storm damage reduction, Morganza to the Gulf of Mexico, Louisiana.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 SECTION 1. MORGANZA TO THE GULF OF MEXICO

4 PROJECT.

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary of the Army shall
6 carry out the project for hurricane and storm damage re-
7 duction, Morganza to the Gulf of Mexico, Louisiana, sub-
8 stantially in accordance with the plans, and subject to the
9 conditions, described in the Reports of the Chief of Engi-
10 neers dated August 23, 2002, and July 22, 2003, at a

1 total cost of \$841,100,000, with an estimated Federal cost
2 of \$546,300,000 and an estimated non-Federal cost of
3 \$294,800,000.

4 (b) OPERATIONS AND MAINTENANCE.—The oper-
5 ation, maintenance, repair, rehabilitation, and replace-
6 ment of the Houma Navigation Canal lock complex and
7 the Gulf Intracoastal Waterway floodgate features of the
8 project described in subsection (a) that provide for inland
9 waterway transportation shall be a Federal responsibility,
10 in accordance with section 102 of the Water Resources
11 Development Act of 1986 (33 U.S.C. 2212).
