A BILL

To designate the annex to the E. Barrett Prettyman Federal Building and United States Courthouse located at 333 Constitution Avenue Northwest in the District of Columbia as the “William B. Bryant Annex”.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*

2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. DESIGNATION.**

4 The annex to the E. Barrett Prettyman Federal

5 Building and United States Courthouse located at Con-

6 stitution Avenue Northwest in the District of Columbia

7 shall be known and designated as the “William B. Bryant

8 Annex”.

1 **SEC. 2. REFERENCES.**

2 Any reference in a law, map, regulation, document,
3 paper, or other record of the United States to the annex
4 referred to in section 1 shall be deemed to be a reference
5 to the "William B. Bryant Annex".

6 **SEC. 3. EFFECTIVE DATE.**

7 This Act takes effect on the date on which William
8 B. Bryant, a senior judge for the United States District
9 Court for the District of Columbia, relinquishes or other-
10 wise ceases to hold a position as a judge under article III
11 of the Constitution.
