## A BILL

For the relief of Jim K. Yoshida.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. VETERAN STATUS.**

4       (a) ENTITLEMENT TO STATUS.—Notwithstanding  
5       any other provision of law, Jim K. Yoshida of Honolulu,  
6       Hawaii, is deemed to be a veteran for the purposes of all  
7       laws administered by the Secretary of Veterans Affairs.

8       (b) TREATMENT OF SERVICE.—Notwithstanding any  
9       other provision of law, the service of Jim K. Yoshida of  
10       Honolulu, Hawaii, as a volunteer member of the United  
11       States Army during the period beginning on July 2, 1950,  
12       and ending on January 17, 1951, shall be deemed to be

1 active military service from which Jim K. Yoshida was dis-  
2 charged under honorable conditions for the purposes of  
3 all laws administered by the Secretary of Veterans Affairs.

4 (c) PROSPECTIVE APPLICABILITY.—No benefits may  
5 be paid or otherwise provided to Jim K. Yoshida of Hono-  
6 lulu, Hawaii, by reason of the enactment of this Act with  
7 respect to any period before the date of the enactment of  
8 this Act.
