To provide for the issuance of a postage stamp commemorating the 450th anniversary of the founding of the first European settlement in the continental United States, at Pensacola, Florida, by Tristán de Luna in 1559.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. COMMEMORATIVE POSTAGE STAMP.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Postmaster General shall
5 provide for the issuance of a postage stamp to commemo-
6 rate the 450th anniversary of the founding of the first Eu-

1 ropean settlement in the continental United States, at
2 Pensacola, Florida, by Tristán de Luna in 1559.

3 (b) DURATION.—Such stamp shall be issued for such
4 period of time as the Postmaster General may determine,
5 but at least throughout calendar year 2009.
