## A BILL

To amend title 5, United States Code, relating to the use of the leave transfer program by wounded veterans who are Federal employees.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. USE OF LEAVE TRANSFER PROGRAM BY**  
4                       **WOUNDED VETERANS WHO ARE FEDERAL**  
5                       **EMPLOYEES.**

6           (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 6333(b) of title 5, United  
7       States Code, is amended—

8                       (1) by striking “A leave” and inserting “(1)  
9       Except as provided in paragraph (2), a leave”; and

1           (2) by adding at the end the following new  
2       paragraph:

3       “(2) The requirement to exhaust annual leave and  
4       sick leave under paragraph (1) shall not apply in the case  
5       of a leave recipient who, while a member of the Armed  
6       Forces, including a member of the National Guard or a  
7       Reserve, sustained a combat-related disability (as defined  
8       in section 1413a(e) of title 10) and is undergoing medical  
9       treatment (as defined by the Office of Personnel Manage-  
10      ment) for that combat-related disability. The preceding  
11      sentence shall apply to a member described in that sen-  
12      tence only so long as the member continues to undergo  
13      medical treatment for the disability, but in no case for  
14      more than five years.”.
