Mr. MORAN of Virginia introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Oversight and Government Reform

# A BILL

To amend title 5, United States Code, to provide that a Federal employee may use up to 2 days of sick leave a year in the performance of community service.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 SECTION 1. AVAILABILITY OF SICK LEAVE TO PERFORM  
4 COMMUNITY SERVICE.

5 Section 6307 of title 5, United States Code, is  
6 amended by adding at the end the following:

7       “(e)(1) Subject to paragraph (2) and in addition to  
8 any other allowable purpose, sick leave may be used by

1 an employee in order to perform qualified community serv-  
2 ice.

3 “(2) The total amount of sick leave used by an em-  
4 ployee under this subsection may not exceed 2 days a year.

5 “(3) For purposes of this subsection, the term ‘quali-  
6 fied community service’ means volunteer service—

7 “(A) performed for a charitable organization  
8 which is participating in the Combined Federal  
9 Campaign; and

10 “(B) which satisfies such other requirements as  
11 the Office of Personnel Management may by regula-  
12 tion prescribe.”.
