A BILL

To provide for a study of measures to achieve energy independence for the United States without adversely affecting the environment.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. ENERGY INDEPENDENCE STUDY.**

4 The Secretary of Energy shall enter into an arrange-
5 ment with the National Academy of Sciences for a study
6 of what measures the United States can take, including
7 what research needs to be undertaken in the short, me-
8 dium, and long term, in order to achieve energy independ-

1 ence for the United States without adversely affecting the
2 environment. The Secretary shall, not later than 1 year
3 after the date of enactment of this Act, transmit to the
4 Congress a report on the results of that study.

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
